**ECE AP 6**  
**Campus Overrides**

**Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to define when campus overrides will be issued to undergraduate students.

**Policy**

Attendance expectations are set based on the scheduled instructional mode, which for undergraduate ECE courses is as follows:

- Starkville and Coast campuses will be scheduled as face-to-face or synchronous online during Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters
- Online campus will be scheduled as asynchronous online during all terms

With the expectation that the student will attend the class per the scheduled instructional mode, campus overrides will generally be granted to:

- Online students who request to enroll in Starkville or Coast campus courses
- Starkville students who request to enroll in Coast campus courses
- Coast students who request to enroll in Starkville campus courses

Campus overrides will be granted to Starkville and Coast campus students who request to enroll in Online campus courses when at least one of the following is true:

- Student is participating in a co-op rotation or full-time internship
- Student is enrolled in their final semester of study with less than a full-time load
- Student will enroll in Online (Campus 5) courses only
- Course is not offered on the student's enrolled campus during the requested term

In rare and extenuating circumstances, exceptions may be approved by the ECE Undergraduate Committee.
